Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

Please accept this letter as our weekly update regarding the status of COVID-19 in our facility. Since the onset of this virus, we have had 48 residents and 18 staff members test positive for COVID-19. We currently have 1 staff member with COVID-19.

As you know, we have been preparing to safely allow visitors at our facility and we are so excited to for you to see your loved ones. As we previously reported, there are many factors that determine when a facility can open up for visitors, up to and including our county's COVID-19 positivity rate, residents' health status, or if there is a COVID outbreak in the facility. At this time, The Pavilion at Creekwood is allowing essential caregiver visits, which are explained below. Our visiting hours are Tuesday-Thursday as well as Saturday and Sunday. These are by appointment ONLY with set times for visitation. Please call M-F between 9-5 to obtain guidance on visitation and to set your appointment.

Essential Caregivers are individuals that have been designated by the resident as someone who provides regular care and support to the resident. Each resident may have up to two (2) Essential Caregivers, but only one can visit at a time. Essential Caregiver visits will be limited in time depending on what our facility can safely accommodate. The visits will occur in designated areas which can be outdoors, in the resident's room or in any area of the facility that limits movement through the facility and interaction with other residents. If you have been designated as an Essential Caregiver, we will provide you with more specific procedures to ensure a safe visit with your loved one. If you wish to become an Essential Caregiver, please discuss this with your loved one or his/her legally responsible party and notify the facility.

Please continue to check our website for weekly updates as well as notification of new cases. As always, we will notify you if we receive confirmation of a new positive case in our facility and we will reach out to you individually if your loved one is displaying symptoms of COVID-19 or tests positive for COVID-19.

Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

WEEKLY UPDATE

10/28/20

Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

Please accept this letter as our weekly update regarding the status of COVID-19 in our facility. Since the onset of this virus, we have had 48 residents and 18 staff members test positive for COVID-19.

Thank you to all of our families for being patient and understanding as we have moved to twice a week testing per the Tarrant County Positivity Rate of 10.6%. We tested 10/27/20 and 10/29/20. At this time, we have no active COVID-19 cases.

Additionally, visitation will be adjusted for the week of Thanksgiving. We will offer visitation on Thanksgiving Day and the day after from 9-3 by appointment only. We will not be offering visitation on November 28-29. We will then resume our regular schedule on December 1, 2020.
