Since the onset of this virus, we have had 48 residents and 21 staff members test positive for COVID-19. One staff member tested positive during our first round of testing this week, which brings our current number of positive staff members to 3.


Once again, I would like to express my gratitude to all of our essential caregivers who have taken our safety precautions, training, and screening so seriously and with such a kind spirit.

As always, we are working hard to keep everyone in our community safe and we will continue to practice the enhanced safety precautions that are known to prevent the spread of COVID-19, such as only essential personnel are allowed inside the facility and we screen them for signs and symptoms of illness prior to entering. Our residents are continually monitored and staff is using PPE as recommended by the CDC. Please accept this letter as our weekly update regarding the status of COVID-19 in our facility. Since the onset of this virus, we have had \_\_\_48\_\_\_ residents and \_\_\_20\_\_\_ staff members test positive for COVID-19.

Thank you to all of our families for being patient and understanding as we have moved to twice a week testing per the Tarrant County Positivity Rate of 11.6%. We tested 11/2/20 and 11/5/20. At this time, we have 2 active staff with COVID-19.

Additionally, visitation will be adjusted for the week of Thanksgiving. We will offer visitation on Thanksgiving Day and the day after from 9-3 by appointment only. We will not be offering visitation on November 28-29. We will then resume our regular schedule on December 1, 2020.

As always, we are working hard to keep everyone in our community safe and we will continue to practice the enhanced safety precautions that are known to prevent the spread of COVID-19, such as only essential personnel are allowed inside the facility and we screen them for signs and symptoms of illness prior to entering. Our residents are continually monitored and staff is using PPE as recommended by the CDC.
