As soon as we have a date, we will let everyone know. Please get your signed consents back quickly as Walgreen's wants them completed prior to their visit.

As always, we are working hard to keep everyone in our community safe and we will continue to practice the enhanced safety precautions that are known to prevent the spread of COVID-19, such as only essential personnel are allowed inside the facility and we screen them for signs and symptoms of illness prior to entering. Currently, we have 5 staff members out with COVID-19 and we have 2 residents on the COVID-19 unit.

Finally, Tarrant county positivity rate is 15%, so please make sure you are current with your COVID-19 tests.
