



COVID NOTIFICATION/UPDATE

June 12, 2020

To Our Valued Residents, Families and Representatives:

We just received confirmation that a resident in our facility tested positive for COVID-19. While we are disappointed that someone has tested positive for COVID after we have worked so hard to prevent the spread of this virus in our facility, we know that we are dealing with an extremely contagious virus. Rather than be discouraged by this case, we are going to take all necessary steps to protect our residents and staff.

We are committed to eliminating this virus from our facility and we will continue to implement and practice enhanced safety precautions recommended by our federal, state and local health officials, such as, only allowing essential personnel inside the facility, performing regular screenings for signs and symptoms of illness prior to entering the building, continually monitoring residents, performing regular deep cleanings, using PPE as recommended by the CDC, providing individual activities as opposed to group activities, implementing isolation protocols as required, and reminding and encouraging staff to practice social distancing and to use hand sanitizer and frequently wash their hands when they are in the facility and out in the community.

As a reminder, we will post updates on our facility website and we will individually notify representatives/families regarding a resident's condition if he/she tests positive for COVID-19 or is displaying symptoms of COVID-19. WEEKLY UPDATE

6/25/2020

Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

Please accept this letter as The Pavilion at Creekwood weekly update to keep you informed about the status of COVID in our facility and what we are doing to keep our residents and staff safe during the ongoing coronavirus pandemic.

As of today, 32 residents and 7 staff members have tested positive for COVID-19. The Pavilion at Creekwood has increased staff screening to twice daily for possible symptoms and the residents are being screened three times daily. We are also testing all staff and residents weekly. Additionally, we have staff assigned to our COVID unit on hall 200 that only take care of those residents. Finally, we are in daily contact with the county health department and Texas Health and Human Services to ensure all control measures are being met.

As a reminder, we continue to closely monitor and follow the recommendations of our federal, state and local health officials. Only essential personnel are allowed inside the facility and we screen them for signs and symptoms of illness prior to entering. Our residents are continually monitored and staff is using PPE as recommended by the CDC. Staff is frequently reminded and encouraged to practice social distancing and to use hand sanitizer and frequently wash their hands when they are in the facility and out in the community. We ask them not to report to work if they have symptoms of illness.

Please continue to check our website for updates, PavilionatCreekwood.com. As always, we will notify you if we receive confirmation of a new positive case in our facility and we will reach out to you individually if your loved one is displaying symptoms of COVID-19 or tests positive for COVID-19.


We are happy to report that, as of today, we have no confirmed cases of COVID-19 in our facility. On May 20, 2020 the facility completed 172 tests that included all residents and staff. Together, we review city, state and government changes and implement them immediately to avoid the spread of COVID-19. Additionally, staff are assigned extra cleaning projects daily that include high touch areas. We are also taking residents outside to the courtyard to get some sun and fresh air. Last Thursday, the city of Mansfield along with other vendors organized a drive thru parade that included driving through our parking lot. We had several residents outside and they had a blast!! It was such a joyous experience to see all the smiles.

As a reminder, only essential personnel are allowed inside the facility and we screen them for signs and symptoms of illness prior to entering. Our residents are continually monitored and staff is using PPE as recommended by the CDC. Staff is frequently reminded and encouraged to practice social distancing and to use hand sanitizer and frequently wash their hands when they are in the facility and out in the community. We ask them not to report to work if they have symptoms of illness.

Please continue to check our website for updates. As always, we will notify you if we receive confirmation of a new positive case in our facility and we will reach out to you individually if your loved one is displaying symptoms of COVID-19 or tests positive for COVID-19.
